MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Requesting Support for Paradrop Operations

1. New procedures have been instituted for requesting support for paradrop operations. Effective 1 July 2010, all units requesting support for operations must first contact LTC Palmer of the Joint Airborne/Air Transportability Training (JAATT) Team located at Scott AFB, Illinois at DSN 779-3332 or commercial (618) 229-3332. The JAATT Team will inform the unit of their ability to support the paradrop requirement if assets are available. If assets are not available, the JAATT Team will inform the unit in writing or via voco that they are unable to provide paradrop support.
2. Upon receipt of a written or voco regret from the JAATT Team, the requesting unit will then contact the OSAA Execution Branch and provide verification of non-support from the JAATT Team. Units requesting paradrop support will only contact the Operational Support Airlift Agency's (OSAA) Execution Branch if the JAATT Team is unable to support their requirement at DSN 656-7212/7153.
3. After the OSAA Execution Branch receives the JAATT Team regret from the requesting unit, the Execution Branch will inform the unit to enter their request for paradrop support into ARMY JALIS. Under **no circumstances** will individual units be authorized to request C-23 support from OSAA Execution or input the request for support into Army JALIS without receiving a notification of non-support from the JAATT Team.
